

## **Alert: Phishing Attempts Take Aim at Credit Union Members**

A text phishing scam targeting credit union members tell recipients their credit or debit card has been locked or deactivated and instructs them to call a phone number. The text message falsely claims to be from a credit union, among them. All of the text messages include the first four digits of the named credit union's debit card BIN, and a phone number to call.

If you receive such a message, do not call the number or reply to the text. Never give out your personal information in response to an e-mail or text. If issues ever arise relating to your debit or credit card — or if you have concerns about your card status — call only the number(s) listed on the back of your card or call Jersey Trades FCU at 1 800 848 2438.
